### Activity Description:

Depart from Ollantaytambo's main square and visit places like the Inca Bridge and Cachiccata quarries, reaching the Pyramid viewpoint while participating in ecological pruning and restoration activities using FMNR methodology. Guided by local experts, you will contribute to the conservation of Andean ecosystems, fire prevention, and the strengthening of community initiatives, all in a unique natural and cultural setting.

**Volunteering in Ollantaytambo – Community of Ollanta**

**Schedule:** Full Day 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM / Half Day 8:00 AM - 12:00 PM

**Meeting Point:** Main Square of Ollantaytambo

**Activity:** Ecological Pruning and Restoration Volunteering

**Destination:** Choquechacca, Ollantaytambo

### Activity Description:

Depart from the main square of Ollantaytambo toward the Central Ollanta community. We'll hike to the archaeological site of Pumamarca to learn about its history and importance, continuing on to the private conservation area of Choquechacca to discover its natural value. Along the way, you will engage in ecological pruning and restoration activities using the FMNR method. Guided by local experts, you'll support Andean ecosystem conservation, fire prevention, and community initiative development.
